

The Community

The school district is primarily rural. Residents, who work in the community, work in light industry, agriculture, logging, printing, stone-cutting, health-care, retail and education. Many travel to Binghamton and its surrounding area for work.

Businesses and services located in Deposit include a pharmacy, restaurants, antique shops, telephone company, bank, a variety of small businesses and a recently opened wood pellet manufacturing plant. A small Industrial Park is located just outside the village limits. The park is home to a lumber yard, a retail bus sales operations and a retail automotive tools manufacturer.

Deposit has a wealth of freshwater streams and ponds accessible by state land for most outdoor activities. Our mountainous landscape makes fishing, hunting and hiking ideal for the outside enthusiast. The West Branch of the Delaware River is a well known haven for fly fishing, canoeing and bald eagle watching. Deposit is located at the junction of Routes 8, 10 and 17 (the future Interstate 86).

The School District

- Encompasses a rural area of approximately 124 square miles in Broome and Delaware Counties. It is approximately 30 minutes from Binghamton, NY along Route 17.
- Employs 130 employees, including three building principals, a Director of CSE and related services and the Superintendent.
- Has approximately 500 students on campus. The classrooms are arranged in a PK-5, 6-8, 9-12 configuration. The schools, bus garage and major athletic fields share one campus in the Village of Deposit.
- Rated one of two top quality high schools in Broome County (USA Today).
