### 2019 HALL OF FAME HONOREE Dennis Warner, Class of 1962



Dennis Warner, class of 1962, went on to receive a Bachelor's Degree in Education from SUNY Oneonta in 1967 and a Master's Degree in Education degree from SUNY New Paltz in 1992. In 1995, Dennis earned a Certificate of Advanced Study in Administration from SUNY New Paltz. For a total of 37 years, Dennis devoted his life to teaching children in the Ellenville School District; fostering in them a love of the arts including English literature, broadcasting and theater production. Following his retirement in 2004, Dennis helped to establish the Ellenville High School radio

station, WELV, and became a local icon with his show "Dennis in the Morning". Dennis devoted much of his outside time to community efforts including acting as the Master of Ceremonies for the annual 9/11 memorial service, volunteering for a local hotline service, and producing "Art in the Windows". With Dennis' passing in 2013, he was remembered as an "old school hippy", "pillar of the community" and a "beloved icon" who inspired many to pursue their dreams. Dennis and his wife, Iris, are the proud parents of two children, Cara and Jesse.

# 2019 HALL OF FAME HONOREE Dr. Chester (Chet) Ray, Ph.D., Class of 1979



Following his graduation from DCS in 1979, Dr. Chester A. Ray attended Ithaca College where he received his B.S. degree in Health and Physical Education. Dr. Ray went on to earn an M.A. in Exercise Physiology in 1985 and a Ph.D. in Exercise Physiology in 1989 from the University of Georgia. Dr. Ray served 18 years as Professor of Medicine at Penn State University College of Medicine. Currently, he serves as the Chair of the Department of Nutrition, Food and Exercise Sciences at Florida

State University. He is also the Director of the Institute of Sports Sciences and Medicine at FSU. Throughout his career, Dr. Ray has devoted his time to researching the effect of physical and mental stress on the autonomic nervous system in humans. Dr. Ray has published over 120 peer-reviewed scientific articles and has received funding for his research from the National Institutes of Health, NASA, and the American Heart Association. He is the proud father of 5 children - Dana, Hannah, Gretchen, Jennifer and Isaac.
