Deposit Central Schools Hall of Fame

The Deposit Central School District was proud to begin its Hall of Fame program in 2017 as a way to recognize outstanding alumni. Nominees are selected for induction into the Hall of Fame based on their local, regional, national or international recognition in one or more areas. These areas may be professional, educational, athletic, cultural or community/charitable.

A committee selects a maximum of three inductees from its pool of nominees. The Hall of Fame Committee will review all nominations and make its selection in the early spring. Nomination forms and letters of recommendation for Hall of Fame consideration are accepted throughout the year.

To honor the Hall of Fame program and its purpose, distinguished honorees are invited to visit and speak with current DCS students about their career path and necessary preparation. Plaques honoring the inductees will be permanently displayed in the renovated trophy hallway in the Middle-High School.



2023 HALL OF FAME HONOREE Mr. Daniel Briggs, Jr., Class of 2003




Dan Briggs, Jr. graduated from the Deposit Central School District in 2003. Since his graduation, Dan has committed himself to the Deposit Community and the students at the Deposit Central School District through his dedication to athletics, most specifically, softball and wrestling. Acting as the assistant coach since 2011, Dan took over as head coach for varsity softball in 2016.

During his tenure as head coach, the Deposit (and merged Deposit-Hancock in 2022) team has won 7 Section IV Championships and 5 State championships. Dan has been nominated New York State Coach of the Year 4 times out of 7 possible seasons and was awarded the title in 2016, 2019, 2021 (Class C) and 2022 by the New York State Sportswriters and Coaches Organization for Girls Sports. Dan's passion for athletics and his impact on the lives of his student athletes has created a lasting legacy not only in Deposit, but also across the State of New York and the entire softball community. Deposit CSD is proud to induct Dan Briggs, Jr. into the DCS Hall of Fame. Dan and his wife, Lauren, live in Deposit, New York.



2023 HALL OF FAME HONOREE Mr. Bernie Neale, Class of 1962



Bernard (Bernie) Neale graduated from the Deposit Central School District in 1962. Following graduation, Bernie attended the Northrop Institute of Technology in Inglewood, CA, where he earned a certificate in Aircraft Maintenance Technology and subsequently his Airframe and Powerplant license from the FAA. From 1965-2007, Bernie developed a remarkable career in the aerospace and aviation industry where he

worked on the initial Apollo Space Program including the Apollo 11 mission which was the first to successfully land on the moon. Beyond his contributions to the aviation and aerospace industry, Bernie amassed an extensive real estate portfolio which spans locations from Boston to Hawaii. His love for travel led him on many adventures which has included spending extensive time in all 7 continents often visiting remote, unexplored parts of countries by land and sea. Bernie's passion for serving others can be seen through his works with the impoverished in Mexico and Dandora, a village on the outskirts of Nairobi, Kenya. Bernie's personal achievements, professional accomplishments, and his dedication to the underserved are the epitome of a Deposit Central School distinguished alumni.
