STANDARDS-BASED REPORT CARDS

Deposit Elementary School is proud to introduce Standards-Based Grading for this school year. The change to a Standards-Based Grading system comes from our district's desire to provide clear communication to our parents to ensure meaningful feedback on your child's growth, both academically and socially. Standards-Based Grading communicates where students are currently at with understanding of a skill vs. an average of how students did in the beginning and end of a unit. This also eliminates student's numerical grades from decreasing due to late assignments or one bad test. Standards-Based Grading communicates how students are performing at the given time of the report card. Please continue to read common Q&A's to Standards-Based Grading further in our newsletter! Deposit Elementary believes this will help all parents to have clear communication about their child's progress!



BREAKFAST
