As you know, we regularly practice safety drills with our students. We work with safety specialists and NYS and local law enforcement to make sure our practices are up-to-date. This year, as part of an on-going capital project, we've added new safety features to the entire district. Here are a few:

- Blue lights have been installed on the outside walls of the buildings on campus to alert persons that the district is in lock-down. If you show up on campus and see the blue lights flashing, you should turn around and drive away from the campus because a lock-down situation is occurring. This will be true during lock-down drills and in the unlikely event that a true lockdown is required.
- In addition to the lights, our district-wide PA (public announcement) system has been upgraded. The new system is integrated throughout the district so that important safety messages are transmitted to both buildings. The system will also make safety announcements outside of the buildings so that persons who approach the campus will know if there is a special circumstance occurring.
- Our phone system has also been reprogrammed to incorporate safety features that are accessible in all classrooms. This includes speed dialing options which allow teachers to notify administration or 9-1-1 if an emergency occurs. In the summer, our replacement of classroom doors and electronic hardware will also be completed.
